JEWS FOR JESUS TO SPEAK

Meyer was born and raised in San Antonio, TX. When he was nine, his Messianic-Jewish mother Joyce led him to a personal faith in the Messiah (Jesus). Though both were Messianic Jews, Stan kept his faith secret throughout high school and into college where he became involved with Campus Crusade for Christ. In his senior year at the University of Texas in Austin, he became public about his faith and rededicated his life to Jesus. He felt called to bring the Messiah to his Jewish people.

After graduating college, Meyer joined the missionary staff of Jews for Jesus. He married Holly Coulsting, a graduate of Moody Bible Institute in Jewish and Modern Israel Studies. The Meyers traveled with the Jews for Jesus singing group, the Liberated Wailing Wall, and then served as missionaries in Los Angeles and Fort Lauderdale. In May 2005, the Meyers flew to the Jiangxi province of China where they adopted their daughter, Carrie-Fu. Tragically, Holly passed away in 2011 from Lou Gehrig's Disease (ALS). Stan holds a Master of Arts in Missiology from Fuller Theological Seminary in Pasadena, CA.

Stan currently serves as a missionary with the Los Angeles branch of Jews for Jesus. The ministry includes meeting one-on-one with Jewish believers and inquirers, distributing gospel literature, and an exciting new college group centered in their two-story building in Westwood Village across the street from UCLA. The greater Los Angeles area has over 450,000 Jewish people.

Jews for Jesus was founded in 1973 by Moishe Rosen, who revolutionized Jewish evangelism with his creative approach. Rosen died in May 2010. David Brickner, a fifth-generation Jewish believer in Jesus, has been the organization's executive director since 1996. Brickner has kept Jews for Jesus on the cutting edge as the ministry has expanded and established branches in fourteen countries, including the United States, Brazil, Israel, Russia, France, and South Africa. "We exist to make the Messiahship of Jesus an unavoidable issue to our Jewish people worldwide," Brickner states. "There are still a few that haven't heard of us!"

To Stan Meyer and other Jews for Jesus staff, the objective evidence of the Hebrew Bible and the New Testament, and the transformation in their our own lives provide ample evidence that Jesus was who he claimed to be—the Jewish Messiah.
